MANAGER'S CORNER

The opening match of the season with Plymouth Argyle was not a thriller, but neither was it devoid of incidents. Disappointing from our point of view that we did not clinch the issue and start with the two points — yet we gained half the tally which is more than we have done in the last few years.

Plymouth were not a bad side and some of their moves developed very smoothly. From the "Tigers" angle, we did not become as constructive as we should have done, and lacked the cohesion that blends a side into top gear.

We can do better I know, and our efforts will be to concentrate on our own shortcomings so that the team will be a strong unit with the determination to match.

The new 3rd Division is undoubtedly going to be strong, and we can look forward to good teams coming to Boothferry Park, so our own aims must be just as formidable, for it is only by the team giving all they have got that success can be achieved.

One very interesting pointer was the form shown by the Reserves in the home match against Barrow. In this game they displayed an eagerness that was matched by some very good football with five goals that were worth seeing. This is the spirit that I want in the Club, and now that the form is beginning to be apparent from these younger players — something we have been building up — we shall have the competition for team places that is so necessary.

Tragic! That is a fitting description of our loss at Swindon. After playing some very good football, and gradually dominating play, the injury occurred to Jock Davidson that completely changed the state of the game, and robbed us of any points. I am more than pleased to announce that there is no fracture of Jock's leg, but the damage sustained will take a time to heal. We all hope he will be back in harness soon.

CLUB MATTERS

Our Visitors

A very warm welcome is extended to our Southern friends, Swindon Town, who are making their first-ever visit to our City tonight. It is quite possible that they may include in their team three ex-Tigers, Johnny Neal, Johnny Stephens and Alan Moore, and we extend to them also a most cordial welcome.

Swindon were first formed in 1881 and became a professional Club in 1894 operating in the Southern League. They became one of the original members of the Football League Division 3 on its formation in 1920. They are known popularly as "The Moonrakers," "The Railwaymen" and "The Robins." Throughout their membership of the Football League they have operated in the 3rd Division South, until the present season when the new 3rd Division operates.

League honours have evaded them and the highest position they have attained in the League Table is fourth place in 1924-25, 1946-47, 1948-49 and 1957-58. They have however been F.A. Cup Semi-finalists on two occasions in 1910 and 1912. A most interesting game is anticipated and we hope to avenge the defeat sustained by us at Swindon last Wednesday.



PEN PICTURES OF SWINDON TOWN PLAYERS

SAM BURTON (*Goalkeeper*). Product of local football. Joined Swindon in 1945. Played for Wilts. Junior eleven which reached final of Counties Tournament 1944-45. Ever present last season. Stands 6' 0". Weighs 13½ stone.

JOHN NEAL (*Right full-back*). Signed from Hull City, after spending one season with King's Lynn, in 1957. A keen tackler, fast in recovery. Represented the South, in North v. South League 3 Representative Match last season. Has been a professional sprinter. Stands 5' 9". Weighs 10 stone 1 lb.

WALTER BINGLEY (*Left full-back*). Born in Sheffield. Signed in the early part of the 1958 season, making his league debut for the "Robins" then, ever present since. Walter came from Sheffield Wednesday, with Bolton previously. He stands 6' 0". Weighs 12 stone.

REX TILLEY (*Right half-back*). Signed this close season from Plymouth. Joined Plymouth from Chippenham. After a period of six years with Plymouth, he has joined the "Robins." Born in Swindon. Stands 5' 11", weighs 10½ stone.

GEORGE HUDSON (*Centre half-back*). Became a Swindon player in September, 1948 and gained his league place in latter half of that season. A native of Havant (Hants) was a professional with Portsmouth before joining the "Robins." Must be one of the strongest centre half-backs in the League. He stands 6' 1½", weighing 15 stone.

MAURICE OWEN (*Left half-back*). Born in Abingdon. Shortly after signing as a professional for Swindon in 1947 he was the target for many offers from Clubs in the first Division, two of them being Wolves and Arsenal. He is 5' 11" tall, weighing 10 stone 13 lbs.

ALAN MOORE (*Right wing*). Signed from Coventry. This will be Alan's second season with the Town. Very clever ball player, and very experienced having seen service with Clubs such as Notts Forest, Hull, Chesterfield and Sunderland. Born at Hebburn. He stands 5' 7", weighs 10 stone 9 lbs.

ANDY MICKLEWRIGHT (*Inside right*). Was with Bristol Rovers and Bristol City before joining Swindon in 1955-56 season. Born in Smethwick. Stands 5' 10", weighs 11 stone 5 lb.

BOB EDWARDS (*Inside left*). Last season was second highest goalscorer with 15 goals. He was ever present last year in the club's best year for some seasons. He joined the town in 1956 from Chelsea. Stands 5' 11", weighing 11 stone 10 lbs. Born at Guilford.

ARNOLD DARCY (*Outside left*). Born at Blackburn. Joined the "Robins" from Wigan Athletic during 1956-57 season. Ever present last year. Played as an Amateur for Accrington Stanley in 1952-53 season. Stands 5' 8", weighs 10 stone 5 lbs.
