#### **CLUB NOTES**

However, Swindon was by far the better side, especially in the first half. The forward line played much better than for a long time, even better than at Bournemouth. John Richards, who has had rather a lean time since his operation for the removal of a cartilage, scored both goals, one in each half. It is good to see John with his name on the score sheet, as it may easily have been at Norwich.

The Reserves, with a very young side, lost rather heavily at Mansfield,

although the score was not a true reflection of the game.

Mansfield lost at Swindon on Good Friday by 5 goals to 0, so not only were they out for revenge, but they were also very keen to win as they stand a chance of promotion to Division I of the London Combination.

Mansfield treated the Swindon party extremely well. We trust we can


