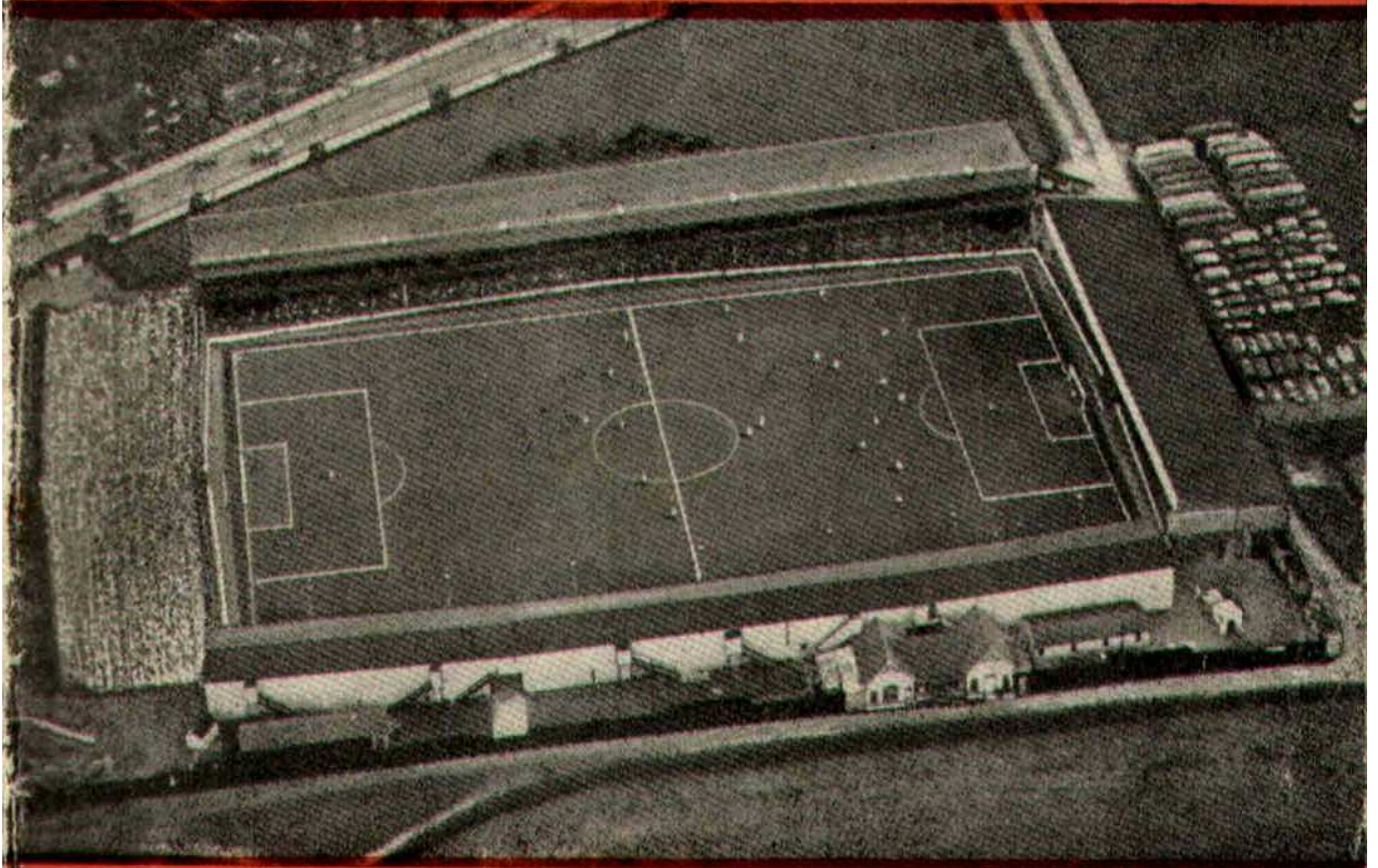

CLUB NOTES

However, such was not to be, and every point is most important. We scored an excellent goal, with fifteen minutes to go before the final whistle, and our hopes rose high. Within a few minutes Brentford equalised with a splendid free-kick, and won the game, through an unfortunate misunderstanding which led to an own goal.

Although at the moment we stand well clear of the bottom four places with 38 points, all games will be dour affairs, as most of our opponents are below us in the league. The only exceptions are Colchester (whom we play today), Port Vale, one point above us, and Coventry, very much in the running for promotion, who visit us, for what might be a deciding game either way, on Wednesday, 4th May.

The spectators at the County Ground enjoyed an excellent game last Saturday. The occasion, Swindon Reserves v. Reading Reserves. The latter are in the running for promotion to Division I of the Combination. Whilst they played quite good football, our young lads deserved their victory. The match was full of incident and excitement. Some of the outstanding features were the good displays of the two young full-backs, and two well taken goals by Jackson, playing at inside-right. In addition both wingers, Corbett and Hoskins, hit the upright, with the goalkeeper completely beaten.

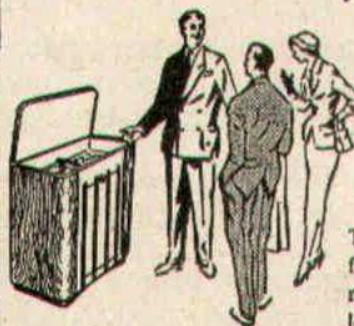
