

Club Notes

Four games in eight days. Three won, and one lost. After the magnificent game with Birmingham, many people had high hopes of a good result at Barnsley. However, it was not to be, but few expected such a heavy defeat. While probably our opponents were the better team, we certainly did not deserve to be beaten by such a margin, even allowing for two goals in the last two minutes. In fact, those persons who saw the game at Barnsley, are of the opinion that Swindon played much better in the second half than we did on Saturday against Lincoln. Yet on that day we recorded our first home victory in the league.

We certainly deserved to win, scored four excellently and worked goals, and yet all spectators will agree we did not display our best form. Those quick direct ground passes we saw so much last year are still missing. The confidence and determination are back, and when we really slip into the rhythm of last season, the team should go from

strength to strength. We must not rest on our laurels, but the past eight days proved very successful. Northampton (away) 2-1, Birmingham (home) 2-0, Barnsley (away) 2-6, Lincoln (home) 4-0. Three wins, 10 goals scored for, and 7 against. Surely bright open, attacking football.

Strange are the ups and downs of football. Lincoln came to Swindon full of hope and confidence of an easy victory. In the week they defeated the strong Crystal Palace team by 4-0, and Swindon lost 2-6. Yet Swindon had one of their easiests tasks for several seasons.

This week is indeed a busy one for Swindon Town F.C. Officials. Tomorrow, Wednesday, the First Team travels to Lytham St. Annes for the Preston game; the Reserves travel to Aldershot to play a London Combination game; and the Youth team play the first round tie at Swansea; Thursday the League Cup match and on Friday,

GRIMSBY TOWN F.C.

This evening we extend a welcome to the Directors, Officials and Players of Grimsby Town Football Club. The Club is enjoying a good season, and the promising start made by the team suggests that it will be challenging strongly for promotion.

On the last occasion the teams met at the County Ground the result was a 3—0 win for Swindon. Our goals were scored by Woodruff, E. Hunt and an own goal.

Details of the players from whom today's team will be selected are as follows:-

PEN PICTURES OF PLAYERS

Malcolm White (Goalkeeper)

Signed as junior from Moseley, a Wolverhampton team. Established himself as first team goalkeeper last season following an injury to former regular 'keeper Alan Barnett. Fearless and particularly good in the air.

Don Donovan (Right Back)

Signed from Everton in 1958, after making 177 League appearances for Goodison Park Club. Born in Cork he has been capped for Eire and can play at wing half. An experienced player with sound positional play.

Brian Keeble (Left Back)

Lincolnshire-born youngster who, after a few Reserve team games, went into the League side at the age of 20 and stayed there with some sound displays. Now 23 he

is regarded as one of the most promising left backs in the Division.

Duncan Welbourne (Right Half)
Signed for Grimsby in 1957 after
playing for Scunthorpe United as
an amateur for one season. A
tough 90 minute player with an
eye for goal.

Keith Jobling (Centre Half)

Club Captain. A product of Grimsby junior football. Signed as a wing half in 1953 for development as centre half after service in forces. A cool, commanding pivot with fine constructive ability.

Ron Cockerill (Left Half)

Signed from Huddersfield Town in 1958 after playing in 40 League games for the Yorkshire club. Tall player who can play centre half. Fine attacking half back with ability to score goals with famed "Cannonball" drive.

John Scott (Outside Right)

Talented player who was formerly with Manchester United. Joined Grimsby in 1956. Toured Canada with Irish F.A. in 1953 and has played twice for Ireland in World Cup. A clever ball-playing winger with stiff right foot shot.

Cliff Portwood (Inside Right)

One of Grimsby's new captures this season. Signed from Port Vale in July where he was top scorer in 1960-61 with 24 League goals. Formerly a winger with Preston North End. A goal-hungry grafter.

Former Portsmouth leader signed by Grimsby in 1956. One of the club's best bargains with his consistent goal scoring, particularly with his head. Born in South Shields he was raised in Slough (Bucks).

Mike Cullen (Inside Left)

Signed from Luton Town in 1958 after playing 117 First Division games for The Hatters. Capped once—as a winger—for Scotland. Former deep-lying centre forward exponent with Grimsby, but now playing normal inside forward
