"Matt" Bell:

It is with very great regret that this week we had to say a last farewell to one of our former players, "Matt" Bell. Our older supporters will remember him as a member of the famous trio Maddison, Gibson and Bell who formed a defence which is still thought of by many as the best Hull City has had. Matt first played for the 'Tigers' in 1919 and was still playing for the club in that memorable F.A. Cup Semi-Final in 1930. His stirring performances won him many friends and he was considered to be very unfortunate not to have won International honours. He always played the game hard but fair. His name, and endeavours for his club, like those of his contemporary 'Geordie' Maddison, who alas is also no longer with us, will always be spoken of in a manner which is rightly reserved for those players who graced the football scene and wore the Hull City colours with honour in a by gone era.

Swindon Town became a Professional club in 1894—thirteen years after the formation of the club in 1881 and played in the Southern League from 1894 to 1920. In 1920 when the Third Division of the Football League was formed Swindon became one of the founder members of this League.

It is not often that a club has more than one nickname but Swindon can boast of having three. One is "The Moonrakers" derived from a Wiltshire legend, "The Robins" by virtue of the club colours and finally they are also known through one of their local industries, as "The Railwaymen".

A glance at page 14 of this programme will show the respective positions of the two clubs prior to today's match. Both teams have 24 points but Swindon have played one game more than us. The position is such however that both clubs badly need the points at stake today.

PEN PICTURES OF SWINDON TOWN PLAYERS

SAM BURTON (*Goalkeeper*). Signed for Swindon in 1945 from the successful County Youth team. Has played consistently well and has been the established First Team goalkeeper for several seasons.

TERRY WOLLEN (*Right back*). Another local boy who made his debut for the First Team when 16 years old. He played the majority of first team games during Season 1960-61. Was later displaced by Ken Jones.

JOHN TROLLOPE (*Left back*). A local boy who joined the Swindon ground staff from school. Was selected for the First Team at the beginning of the Season 1960-61, when he was 16 years old and was ever present during that season.

KEITH MORGAN (*Right half*). A strong, attacking wing-half, who joined Swindon as a youth player from Westbury. Played in every first team game during 1960-61.

MAURICE OWEN (*Centre half*). The team captain and oldest member of the team. Formerly a centre-forward, he has had a long and outstanding period of service with the Club. Has played in several representative games.

PETER CHAMBERLAIN (*Left half*). A utility player who has been with the Club for three years. Was signed originally from Leicester City. Scored five goals in one game from the left half position.

MIKE SUMMERBEE (*Outside right*). Born in Cheltenham, he is another product of the Swindon Youth policy. Another of the players wanted by several Clubs.

ERNIE HUNT (*Inside right*). Joined the Club's ground staff from school. A member of the First Team at 16 years old, he is a player of outstanding ability for whom the Club has had many offers. A local boy, he is just eighteen years old. Was top goal scorer 1960-61.

JACK SMITH (*Centre forward*). Joined the Robins from Watford during the close season. He was formerly with Hartlepool United. A strong, forceful player with the ability to get the expected goal.

BILL ATKINS (*Inside left*). At present in the services, he joined Swindon from Aston Villa at the end of the 1958-59 Season. A strong ball playing forward. He has played several representative matches while in the Army.

ARNOLD DARCY (*Outside left*). Joined the Club in November, 1956 from Wigan Athletic. In spite of his lack of inches he is a strong forceful winger with a powerful shot.

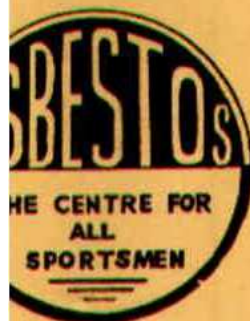

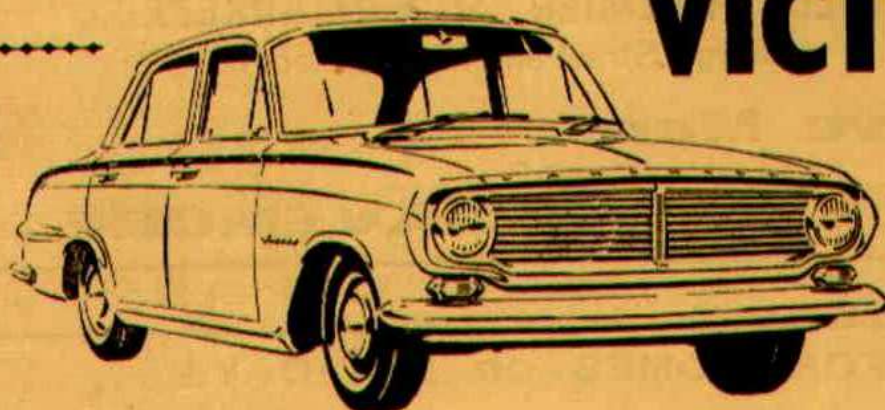
