Club Notes

The victory at Shrewsbury was a very pleasant surprise. It certainly was sweet revenge for the home defeat inflicted upon us on 11th November, 1961, immediately following our exit from the F.A. Cup at Kettering. The next week we were again defeated, this time at Peterborough 2-3. So today, again we have an old score to pay off.

However, back to the game at Shrewsbury. Our lads played really well on a hard, dry ground. At half-time we were "one up" as a result of a well-taken goal by Bill Atkins from a centre by Jack Smith.

After the interval we continued to dominate the game, and further goals were scored by Bill Atkins and Jack Smith, The home side scored near the end of the match. This was our fourth away win of the season. Rather a good performance, as we have won only seven of our home games. Continuing comparisons, we have drawn eight at home and six away, but we have fulfilled one more away game. We now have five home and four away matches.

Swindon occupies fifteenth position in the league table, and are seven clear points above Lincoln in twenty-first position. Nevertheless, we cannot let points slip; the gap can soon narrow.

The Board spent a very pleasant evening last Monday as guests of The Worshipful the Mayor (Ald. T. G. Gay). His Worship is one of our oldest (please excuse the term) supporters, having followed the fortunes of Swindon Town Football Club for fifty years.

Thank you, Mr. Mayor; may you enjoy many more happy seasons at the County Ground.

Last week, two games concerning outside organisations were played on the Ground, viz:-

29th March — Wiltshire Premier League v. Hellenic League. Spectators 327.

31st March — Wiltshire Senior Cup Competition—Highworth Town v. Malmesbury Town. Spectators 616.

It would appear from the above figures that such matches arouse little interest. It seems certain the gate, especially in the first instance, will not cover expenses.

The replay at Peterborough resulted in a 2-1 win for Swindon.

Jack Walls (Goalkeeper)

Born Co. Durham, came from Barnsley 5 years ago for small fee; full-time player this season; agile with safe pair of hands.

Dick Whittaker (Right Back)

Eire International; signed for Chelsea when a boy, remained there 9 seasons, joined Peterborough United last season and helped gain promotion with his strong tackling and intelligent covering.

Jimmy Walker (Left Back)

Previous clubs — Sheffield United and Huddersfield Town, Six-footer, strong and fast,

Jimmy Rayner (Left Back)

Was leading goalscorer for two sea-

sons when playing centre forward; converted to right half, he improved with every game; previous clubs—Bury and Grimsby.

Norman Rigby (Centre Half)

Captain and centre half for eleven seasons; came from Notts County, where he figured at left back; dominant pivot.

Keith Ripley (Left Half)

On the books of Leeds, Norwich and Mansfield before coming to Peterborough last year; plays anywhere; powerful player.

Billy Hails (Outside Right)

Joined us five years ago from Lincoln City; fast go-ahead winger who gets goals.

Dennis Emery (Inside Right)

Six-foot inside forward, clever schemer with deadly shot in either foot.

Terry Bly (Centre Forward)

Another six-footer transferred from Norwich City, with whom he starred during the famous Cup run three years ago; leading League scorer last season with 52 goals.

Ray Smith (Inside Left)

Now in his sixth season, came from Hull City; nippy, tenacious attacker.
