



We would not ask anyone to do anything which we would

not attempt ourselves.

The writer has been able to introduce the "County Ground" habit to two newcomers to the town, during this season, and they have now become fervid supporters.

Those of us who have been camping at the County Ground

for a long time can still do much more to help the Club.

It was pleasing to read that a panel of referees regarded the crowd at Swindon as the best behaved in the South. We hope that we shall never give them cause to change their views.

Before the halo gleams too brightly we should remind ourselves that, probably, the players have helped us to acquire our gentle demeanour (!!!) for, where there is success, there is likely to be less misbehaviour. It is lack of success, and the sense of frustration which follows, which often causes the crowd to become disgruntled and unruly.

The referees themselves, of course, are an important factor in the matter of the behaviour of the crowds, and, in addition, the conduct of the visiting supporters plays a large part, and

can either make or mar the reputations of their hosts. Arguments usually generate more heat than light, and are unde-

sirable at football matches.




