#### **CLUB NOTES**

Today we entertain the League leaders, Leeds United, with the knowledge that we drew earlier in the season when we visited the Yorkshire club.

Last Saturday we gained an away point at Rotherham, and the previous week we defeated the strong and in form Manchester City in the Third Round of the F.A. Cup.

We therefore approach this fixture against the top club confidently. In the Cup game the team produced some of its early season form. It was a splendid match—three excellent goals, many near misses, and good saves, especially by Dowd, the visiting goalkeeper. Unfortunately, the City played most of the second half with ten men, due to the fact that Murray, the centre-forward, slipped and injured a cartilage in the knee.

Referring to the Cup-tie, many people think such games are money-spinners. Unfortunately, that is not the case. To begin with, the attendance was only 18,000 compared with 28,000 for the league game—a loss of 10,000 spectators.

#### CLUB NOTES-CONTINUED

After all expenses have been met, such as advertising, referee, police, visiting team, etc., the balance remaining is divided into three parts: one-third to the home club, one-third to the visitors, and one-third to the Football Association. Out of a total of £3,448 11s. 9d. receipts for the Manchester game, the net amount to Swindon Town F.C. was £755 2s. 8d. A home gate really has to pay for two weeks' outgoings, wages, upkeep of ground, etc. A Cup run creates interest, enthusiasm, and often brings difficulties, but is not a road paved with gold.

The next match, at Aldershot, has certainly brought many problems. Our total allocation of tickets is 4,000, and the method of distribution at today's game was decided upon after much thought and consideration of the matter. Everyone has the same chance of obtaining a ticket. Obviously, some very loyal supporters are going to be disappointed. That is bound to happen with the small number of tickets available. However, with a little give and take and goodwill all round, no doubt the keen supporter should be able to see the game. Whatever system is devised, difficulties occur and people are disappointed. We are certain that with 16,000 people packed in the Aldershot ground, some discomfort will be felt by many spectators. We are sure also that our lads face a hard task. After their great win over Aston Villa, our opponents will be very confident. Whilst we shall take our full quota of supporters (and we know they will make themselves heard) about 12,000 will be behind the home team, who will have the advantage of playing on their own ground.

Also we must make sure the whole thing is right, rather than hurry the matter and in a few years' time begin another project.



#### SUPPORTERS' CLUB NOTES CONTINUED

The Leeds Club is one of the comparatively younger clubs of the Football League. During the season 1919-20 the old Leeds City Club — members of the Second Division — disbanded, and Port Vale were elected to take over the remaining fixtures.

At the commencement of season 1920-21 the newly formed Leeds United Club were elected to the Second Division to the exclusion of Grimsby Town who, during that season, participated in the freshly constituted Third Division.

Swindon Town met Leeds United in a Cup Tie at the County Ground in 1921-22 and won 2—1. Both of the Swindon goals were scored by Fleming. Swindon's team was Skiller; Colebourne, Macconachie; Langford, Hawley, Wareing; Phillipson, Fleming, Rogers, Johnson, Davies.

In the past several Leeds United players have joined the Town, including Alan Fowler, Shanks and the Stephens twins.

In war or peace at home or abroad, the Royal Air Force Police Dog is now recognised as an indispensable weapon in our security armour. Whether in the torrid heat of Aden and the Far East or the chill of a Scottish moor, whether patrolling in Cyprus or guarding vital installations and aircraft in the heart of England, the R.A.F. Police Dog is in its element. Tenacious, loyal, intelligent, strong, these are the sterling qualities of the dogs. Their handlers have immeasurable faith in them, and there is little wonder they are known as the finest police dogs of their kind.

Training is carried out at the R.A.F. Police Depot, where the R.A.F. Police handler, a volunteer for this work, is trained with the dog.

With its acute sense of smell the dog will detect and apprehend an intruder who might otherwise escape a sentry whose vigilance has been defeated by darkness. A dog will seize an intruder and hold on until recalled. Should the intruder be unwise enough to assault the handler his dog will attack without command. R.A.F. Police Dogs have died in defence of their handlers, so undivided is their loyalty.

The dogs now serving in the Royal Air Force were presented by civilian owners whose one desire was to find a suitable home for their dog where it would be usefully employed and well cared for. Gifts of suitable dogs would be gladly accepted and owners of Alsatians, between the ages of eighteen and thirty months, who feel disposed to present them to the Royal Air Force are invited to write to:—
