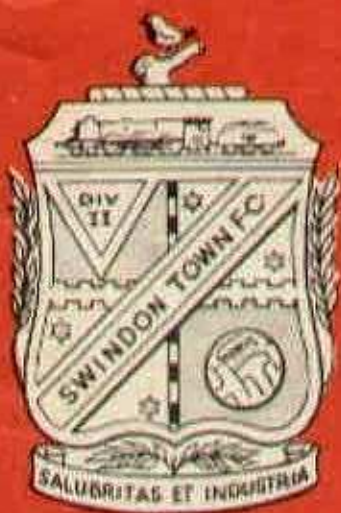
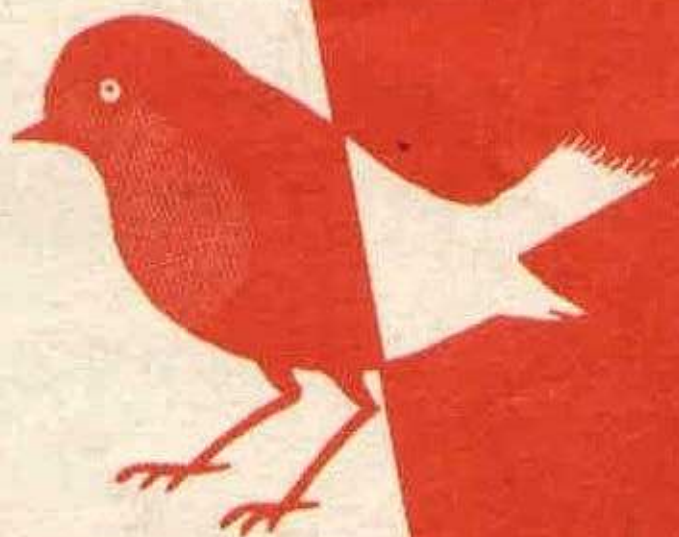

the endeavour, the fight, and above all the skill. We saw some of our real football, man to man, easy flowing style reminiscent of the early weeks of last season. By half-time Swindon were three goals to one in the lead, and well on top. The second half was equally as entertaining as the first, although only one goal was scored by each side. Such displays will bring back the success and enthusiasm of last year. Certainly the team is buoyed up by the return to form as much as the actual results.

Our league position is still rather low, but a glance at the table will show what a small margin of points separate almost all the twenty-two clubs.

Today we entertain old friends and rivals in Southampton. Fellow members of the original Southern League for almost thirty years, and founders of League Division III in 1920, many battles have been fought between the two clubs.

The most outstanding was probably in Season 1947-48, when Southampton defeated us at The Dell, three goals to nil, in the Fifth Round of the Cup.

Southampton gained promotion to Division II after only two seasons in the new Division III. That year 1921-22 they obtained a record number of points, 61 out of a possible 84, and produced an outstanding defensive record, conceding only 21 goals in 42 matches. That was the period of two great full backs—right back Tom Parker, and left back Fred Titmuss. Both later played for England. The former joined the Arsenal, and still is a frequent and welcome visitor to the County Ground. Titmuss was also transferred, but to Fulham.

Another outstanding player, who began with Southampton, was of course Mr. A. Ramsay, who moved to Tottenham,

played right back for England and is now the successful manager of the England Team. An outstanding personality in World Football.

Today the club still boasts a current English International, outside right Terry Paine, who has been capped many times, and also the present captain of the Welsh team which defeated Scotland a week ago, right back Stuart Williams. Two other players, Tony Knapp (centre half) and Martin Chivers (centre forward) have toured with England parties, while two others, John Sydenham (outside left) and David Burnside have been capped for the England Under 23 XI.

Last season Southampton won at the County Ground by two goals to one, and in the last match of the season inflicted on Swindon their heaviest defeat, namely six goals to nil.

Swindon has much to get back. We are sure it is our turn to collect the points, and shall be happy to see a repeat of the last two home games — namely four goals by our lads.

This evening's collection is for the benefit of Mike Summerbee. He completes five years as a professional with the Club in March, 1965, and I am sure you will all agree he has always given outstanding service. We hope you will respond to this appeal with your usual generosity.

OUR VISITORS

It is our pleasure to welcome the Directors, Officials and Players of Southampton Football Club for this evening's game.

Details of the players from whom today's team will be selected are as follows:—

JOHN HOLLOWBREAD (Goalkeeper)

A native of Enfield, Middlesex, John joined the Saints from Tottenham Hotspur during the close season, having completed thirteen years with the London club. A fearless, reliable keeper who last season kept Scottish International Bill Brown out of the Spurs side.

STUART WILLIAMS (Right Back)

Born in Wrexham, Stuart joined the Saints from West Bromwich Albion in September 1962 after spending twelve years at The Hawthorns. This former Welsh skipper is one of the coolest defenders in the game today.

DENIS HOLLYWOOD (Left Back)

Born in Govan, Scotland, this Youth International signed professional forms for the Saints in October 1960. Originally a wing half, this young defender seems to have a great future in front of him.

TOMMY HARE (Wing Half)

Born in Motherwell and signed from a Scottish junior side in 1963.

DAVID PATON (Centre Half)

A Scot, born at Saltcoats. Joined the Saints from St. Mirren in 1963.

KEN WIMSHURST (Right Half)

Born in South Shields, Ken was quietly transferred from Wolves in July 1961 as an inside forward. Converted to wing-half he has become an outstanding constructive player.

TONY KNAPP (Centre Half)

A native of Newstead Colliery, Notts, Tony joined the Saints from Leicester City for a large fee in 1961. The Club Captain, Tony is strong in the air and possesses remarkable powers of recovery. Representative honours.

CLIFF HUXFORD (Left Half)

Born in Stroud, Gloucestershire, joined the Saints from Chelsea in 1959, this tenacious and determined tackler captained the side during the Club's promotion season.

DAVID CHADWICK

David came to The Dell as an amateur in 1958 and signed professional forms in October 1960. David's talents are not only confined to football—he is also interested in music and art.

BOBBY WILKINSON

Signed amateur forms March 1961 and turned professional in October last. Born Colchester.

TERRY PAINE (Outside Right)

Born in Winchester, this flying winger was a product of the youth system at The Dell. This brilliant two-footed player who is capable of playing on either wing has figured prominently in the England side during the past two seasons. Has been described as a natural successor to Matthews.

JOHN SYDENHAM (Outside Left)

Like Paine, a product of the Nursery, he made his debut in the 1956-57 season, and except when on National Service has played regularly. Southampton born, he has represented England several times at Under-23 level.

JOHN McGUIGAN (Inside Forward)

A native of Motherwell. Transferred to Southampton from Scunthorpe United in August 1963, having previously served with St. Mirren, Southend United and Newcastle United.

MARTIN CHIVERS (Centre Forward)

A local boy who, after only one season of first team soccer, is already an England Under-23 International. A product of the Nursery, he signed professional forms in September 1962. He stands 6ft. 2in. and possesses a lethal shot with either foot.

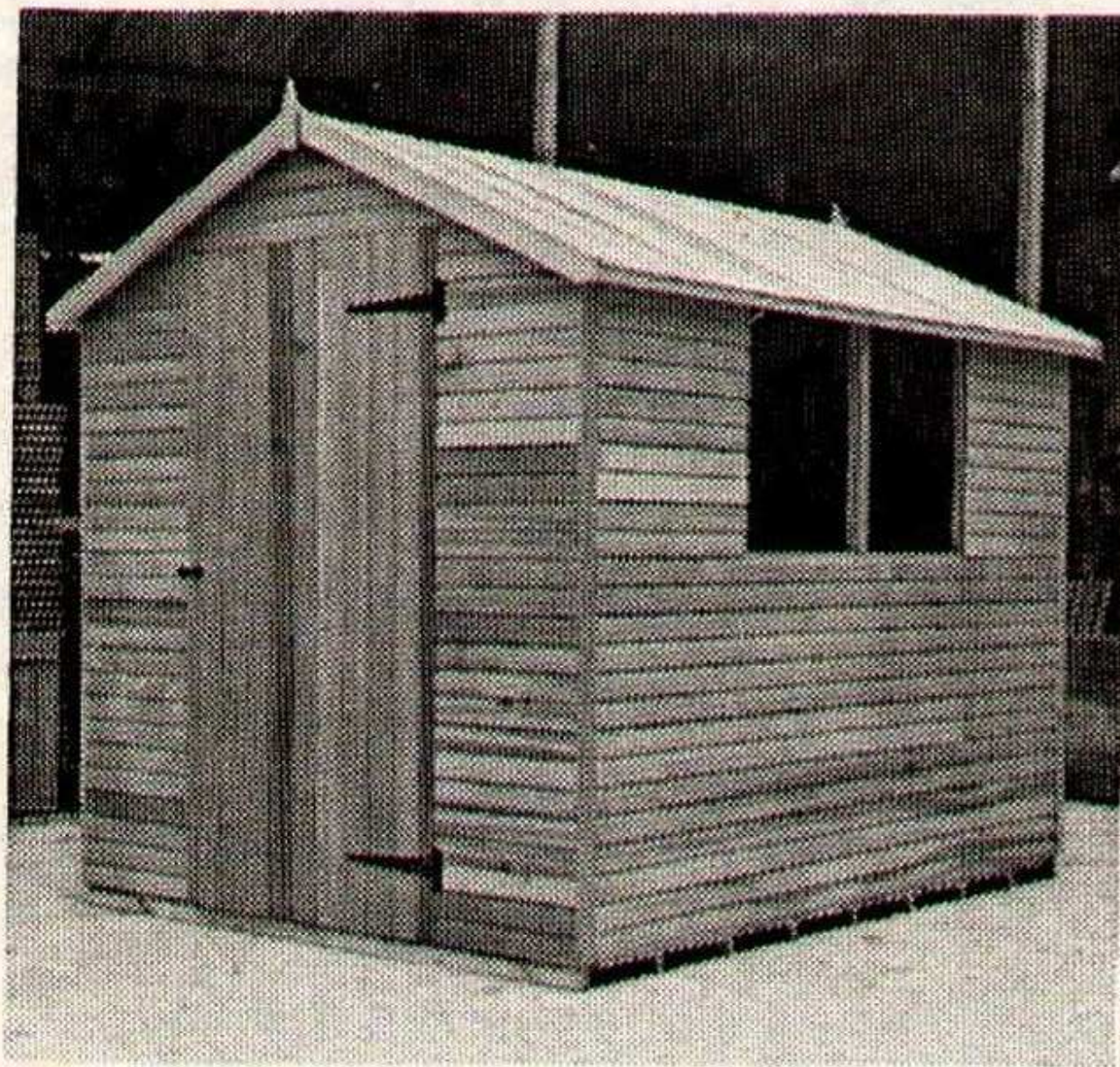
GEORGE O'BRIEN (Inside Forward)

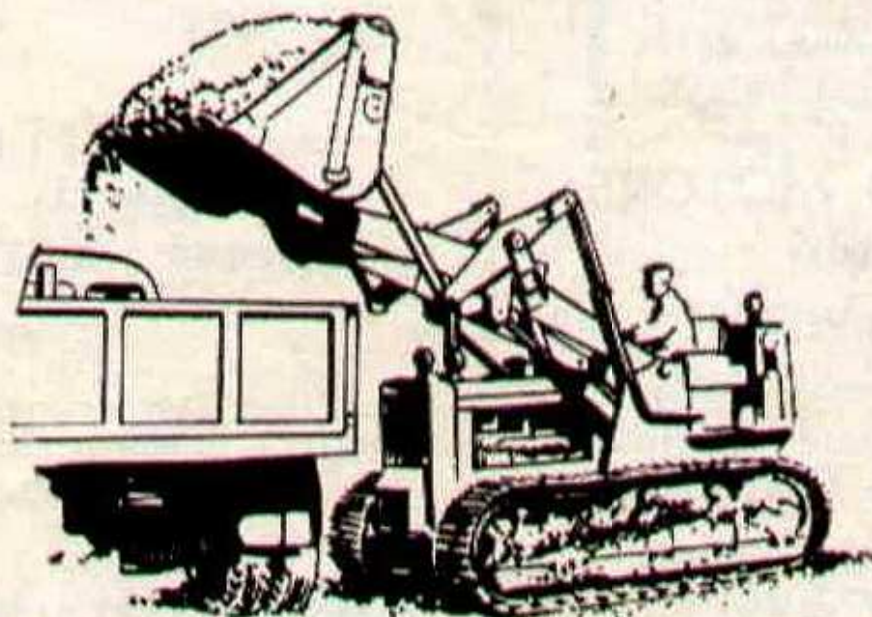
