## CITY WERE BETTER THAN THE SCORE SUGGESTS

The 4—1 reverse at Shrewsbury gave a rather poor impression of the City team's display at Shrewsbury on Saturday, and the final score should have been much closer on the run of play. There was a lot of good and clever football from the City side, even if at times the team was inclined to take things too complacently. We are confident that the team will settle down and do well in the Third Division. David Dunmore was twice unlucky in hitting the post.

Our home programme opens with two hard fixtures, for after Swindon Town's visit tonight, we have Grimsby Town at Bootham Crescent on Friday evening. The professional strength of the club is now 22 with the recent signing of Eamonn Dunphy from Manchester United.

Both Paul Aimson and Billy Rudd have now signed the new contracts, and we are looking forward to them maintaining last season's high standard. Billy will again captain the side.

Once again there is a big proportion of evening games in our league programme—15 altogether, as last season's experience proved that night matches are better supported.

In an effort to build up our resources, the club has again concentrated on young players, whom we hope will quickly settle down. We have a great deal of faith in their ability, and no doubt before the season ends they will stake claims for a place in the senior side.

## SCORED F.A. CUP FINAL GOAL

Ken Keyworth, newly-signed Swindon Town centre forward, led the Leicester City attack in the 1962-3 F.A. Cup final and scored City's goal in a match won 3—1 by Manchester United.

He was also at inside left in the 1960-61 final, when Spurs beat Leicester 2—0.

He left Leicester for Coventry City, from whom Swindon Town signed him last week. Before that, Keyworth played for Rotherham United with the present Swindon manager, Danny Williams.

Here are pen pictures of the players from whom the Swindon Town team will be selected for tonight's match.

**Peter Downsbrough**, goalkeeper. Signed from Halifax Town last week. Halifax developed him from local football.

**Owen Dawson**, right back. Had experience with Portsmouth before joining Swindon three years ago.

**John Trollope**, left back. Another product of local football who has been with the club for more than five seasons. Introduced into the team when only 17 and takes his benefit against Reading on November 6.

**Keith Morgan**, right half. One of several players discovered in junior football and developed by the club.

**Tom Hallett**, centre half. Was at one time a full back and joined Swindon from Leeds United in June, 1963. Gained a regular first team place towards the end of last season.

**Gordon Atherton**, left half. Cost a big fee when signed from Bury last season. Is a strong, constructive type of player.

**John Weaver**, outside right. This product of junior football gets his promotion because of the transfer of Michael Summerbee to Manchester City last Friday.

**Ernie Hunt**, inside right. Schemer of the attack and has played for England under 23 team on tour. He has been seeking a transfer.

**Ken Keyworth**, centre forward. The subject of a transfer from Coventry City last week. He has also played for Rotherham United and Leicester City, and when at Leicester appeared in two F.A. Cup finals, though he was on the losing side on each occasion.

**Dennis Brown**, inside left. Cost a big fee from Chelsea last season and is nicknamed "bullets" because of his aggressive, energetic play.

**Donald Rogers**, outside left. Played in the England Youth team and one of the best ball players in the Town side.

**Roger Smart**, substitute, inside forward. Another player found in local football and one who can also play wing half. Took his benefit in the opening game of the season against Oxford last Saturday.
