TWO MINUTES FROM GROUND

Earlier in the season we had won at Shrewsbury by 2-1, with goals scored by Summerbee and Jackson.

Our visitors have often proved our "bogey team". Some of us remember Season 1960-61, the first year of the Football League Cup. We played them three times before losing 0-2 at home. To make matters worse, Shrewsbury also visited the County Ground in the F.A. Challenge Cup, and again won the game, after Swindon had missed a penalty.

A special and unique function was held at the County Ground last Tuesday—a Reunion of former Town players of 60 years and over. What a wonderful occasion! What memories revived! What quips and jokes!

Not only were the "old timers" thrilled to visit the County Ground and meet their colleagues of yester-year, but to us who were privileged to be present it was wonderful to see the joy and delight of these players who did so much to make the name of Swindon Town resound throughout the football world. Many great names were mentioned during the talks and discussions, not least of all "Snobber" Harold Fleming, "Tonker" Wiltshire and his little dog, and the one and only Sam Allen. What jokes and remarks! Probably the highlight was the meeting of Tommy Bolland and Bob Jefferson. What comments! "Get cracking down the wing-no fiddling, and get the ball over." "How's your sprinting these days?" Men over eighty years of age. It really was marvellous to see three men photographed by the Dubonnet Cup, which they helped to win in Paris in 1910-fifty-six years ago. What they said about carrying it on board ship at Boulogne, but they were pleased to see it still held a pride of place in the Tea Room.

These players were especially pleased to meet two exdirectors who worked so hard for the Club between the two world wars—Mr. White and Mr. Priston.







### SUPPORTERS' CLUB NOTES

As these Notes are being written before Saturday's match with Q.P.R., I shall have to confine myself to hoping that our team gave us a repeat of the fine win at Mansfield. I do not like referring to any particular player—after all, football is a team game, and any success out of the ordinary by any player is normally the result of previous work by someone else. So perhaps I should congratulate the half-backs and forwards for helping Owen Dawson and John Trollope to score a goal each, and congratulate them for finishing off two attacking moves so successfully. We shall all, no doubt, be looking for the new 4-2-4 set up which was referred to in the newspaper reports.

As promised in our last Notes, I am taking this opportunity of telling most of our supporters more about Peter Chambers, whose late widow, Mrs. F. Chambers, donated £500 to the Supporters' Club in memory of her late husband. Bert Davies, who played under Peter Chambers as a youth, has kindly

supplied me with the information.

Peter Chambers was transferred to Swindon Town in 1907 from Bristol City and was elected Captain the same year. At this time, Swindon Town were playing in the old Southern League and many of the older supporters still believe that it was a retrograde step when, in 1921, the Football League formed the old Third Division with its two sections, North and South.

Peter played at left half-back and was unfortunate, in the same year, to break his jaw in a cup-tie against Wolves at Molineux. The accident happened just before full-time, with the score 0-0, but after Peter left the field, in the remaining few minutes of the game, Wolves scored twice to win the tie. The accident happened in a collision with the Reverend Hunt, who was an England amateur international and played with Wolves for many years.

Of those who played with him, Bert Davies, Jock Walker (left back and nine times a Scottish international whilst with Swindon), Bob Jefferson (right wing), and Harold Fleming are still well remembered by older supporters. Incidentally, Bert tells me that Peter always called Harold Fleming "Kid". The first three players mentioned were amongst those at the Reunion at the 63 Club last Tuesday evening.

Peter played at Swindon for some years in the Reserve team—during which he made his mark as a wonderful coach for the young reserve players, and established himself as a first-class clubman—until the outbreak of World War I.

After his playing days were over, he remained in Swindon as landlord of the "Red Lion", Moredon until he finally retired to Somerset. Nevertheless, after the First World War he coached the post-war Club players for a year or so, and no doubt gave further valuable service.

Somehow, this latest donation seems in character. The Supporters' Club must take good care to ensure that it is used as a lasting tribute to the memory of Peter Chambers, a Captain

of Swindon Town Football Club.


