#### MEET DENIS MOCHAN . . .



ONE of the most experienced full-backs to be acquired by Colchester for several seasons Denis Mochan signed on a free transfer from Nottingham Forest only a few weeks ago, really strengthens our hand for this interesting season.

In his four years at Forest, taking in over 120 First Division matches, Mochan has played successfull against some of the best wingers in the country.

The odd thing is that Denis, aged 30 and born near Falkirk, played much of his early football as a forward and indeed scored many goals for his first senior Club, East Fife. He joined them after a promising schoolboy career from Kilsyth, the Scottish Juniors and indeed has been playing football since he was eight.

Mochan comes from a football mad family. His father was a prominent player in the Scottish junior ranks and two of his three brothers are in senior football, the best-known being Neil Mochan once with Middlesbrough and now player-coach at Glasgow Celtic.

From East Fife Denis moved on to Raith Rovers and then into English football and it cost Forest all of £12,000 to bring him to Nottingham, where he

spent four memorable seasons.

His first game for the Forest was a third round F.A. Cup tie against Wolves in 1963 and since then he has been more or less an automatic choice until November of last year. It's not surprising that several clubs including Crystal Palace, Doncaster Rovers and Lincoln City have been keen on his services.

Of the many star wingers he has opposed Denis reckons Ian Callaghan of Liverpool, who was in England's World Cup squad, one of the very best.

Peter Downsborough (Goalkeeper). Born Halifax. Signed at the commencement of last season from Halifax Town where he was a product of local football. A fearless, agile player who has done much to strengthen the Town's defence.

Norman Oakley (Goalkeeper). Born Norton-on-Tees. Joined the Club from Hartle-pools United in March, 1964.

Tony Hicks (Goalkeeper). Born Swindon. He has been with Swindon for five years. He joined the Club as a schoolboy and progressed through the ranks of the junior teams before becoming one of the three senior goalkeepers.

Owen Dawson (Right-back). Born Hatfield. Joined the Club from Portsmouth four years ago, and has been a regular First Team player ever since. A Youth International.

John Trollope (Left-back). Born Swindon. Another local player who joined the Swindon groundstaff from school. Was selected for the First Team at the beginning of the 1960-61 Season when he was just 16 years old, and was ever-present during that season. A strong player who has proved his worth in a good defence.

Keith Morgan (Right-half). Born Trowbridge. A tall, fast, attacking player who progressed through the Club's junior teams after joining Swindon ground staff at the age of 16. He has been a regular player for the Town's First Team.

Mel Nurse (Centre-half). Signed from Middlesbrough at the beginning of last Season. He is a strong forceful player and is an International with Wales. His ability and experience have done much to strengthen the team's defence.

Stan Harland (Left-half). Born Liverpool. Signed during close Season from Carlisle United. He is a forceful player and is able to go upfield to back up the forwards in attack.

Eric Weaver (Outside-right). Born Rhymney. Joined the Club from Southern League Trowbridge Town after his service with the R.A.F. He played Representative football in the services, and since becoming a professional with Swindon he has proved his worth, being able to play in most positions in the forward line.

Roger Smart (Inside-right). Born Swindon. Another local-born player who joined the Club direct from Swindon Schoolboys team. At 17 he was appearing regularly at centre-forward in the Reserve team, but he excels as a deep-lying inside-forward or wing-half.

Keith East (Centre-forward). Born Southampton. A strong, forceful player. He joined the Town from Portsmouth in 1964. Last season he was the Club's top goal scorer with 25 goals.

Dennis Brown (Inside-left). Born Reading. Joined the Club from Chelsea for a very large fee in November 1964. A fast inside-forward with a deadly shot.

Donald Rogers (Outside-left). Born Paulton. A player of outstanding ability. He has long been the target for many of the English First Division Clubs. He has played for England Youth Team and also the England Under 23 XI.

Joe Butler (Full-back). Born Newcastle. Joined Swindon from Newcastle United in August, 1965. A tenacious player whose speed and ability amply makes up for his lack of inches. He joined the Club's Junior Team and graduated to the senior ranks before joining the Town.

Jimmy Lawton (Centre-forward). Born Middlesbrough. When Swindon played Darlington in the Football League Cup last season Lawton was one of the outstanding players in the Darlington team. As a result of his performance Swindon immediately signed this player. A strong forceful leader. He scored 28 goals in the Darlington First Team in Season 1964-65.

Ken Skeen (Inside-forward). Born Cheltenham. He played originally as an amateur with the Club but subsequently joined Trowbridge Town and re-joined Swindon as a professional in September 1964.

Jimmy Giles (Centre-half). Born Kidlington. A versatile player who has played at centre-forward for the Robins where he proved to be a strong, forceful leader, and also centre-half where his strength did much to add to the defence.

Rod Thomas (Full-back). Born Glyncorrwg. A former youth player with the Club, whose speed and strength have made him a reliable defender. Made his debut in the First Team last Season.

Bruce Walker (Outside-left). Born Westwood Lay. Joined Swindon from County football. Though he is not a big player his ability and speed make him a menace to any defence.

TEN YEARS AGO-Monday, 24th September, 1956. Colchester United 4, Exeter City 0.

A gala evening. Our great win with goals from Benny Fenton, Kevin McCurley, and Ken Plant (2), sent us soaring to second place in the Third Division table. Exeter were outclassed and we completed a double, having beaten them 2-0 away the previous Wednesday.
