Club Notes

We are very pleased to welcome Swindon here tonight as one of the season's star opponents. They have created immense interest and enthusiasm in the football world by their exploits in the Football League Cup.

This reached a climax when Swindon won at Burnley in the first leg of the semifinal last Wednesday. They now only need a home draw against the Lancashire club to carry the Third Division flag at Wembley in the final against either Arsenal or Spurs.

But the cup is not their only ambition. Swindon have been among the top group of clubs all the season in Division Three and are making a strong fight for promotion.

Our supporters must have been disappointed that we are drawn away in the F.A. Cup, for we were hoping for another home tie. As it is we must visit Brighton, who beat Kidderminster in the replay last Wednesday after drawing the first game on their own ground.

The Cobblers will be all-out to get into the hat for the third round. Our record away from home is a useful one and we will be trying hard for success. The Cobblers have twice drawn at Brighton in the League Cup in recent years, and we hope for a similar result at least.

On Saturday we had a curtain-raiser for the cuptie when we visited Brighton in the league. The result was a 1-1 draw and gave little real clue how the next game will go except that it will be a very hard keen game.

We went ahead in six minutes. Bob Hatton was unfortunate to have a scoring shot fisted over the bar by a defender, but Frank Rankmore made no mistake with the consequent penalty kick. Incidentally Frank was playing under the handicap of having his right wrist bandaged, and having had six stitches in his chin, during a training accident.

Our defence played well and held out until the last 15 minutes when the home team got on terms. Our own forwards enjoyed a fair share of pressure and came near to a goal several times.

Our cuptie with Margate, the last home match, brought an entertaining struggle, with John Roberts scoring twice, and John Fairbrother getting the other goal in a 3-1 success.

We commend our supporters to reserve games. The 772 who turned out to watch the match with a powerful Birming am reserves team last Tuesday were well rewarded.

The youngsters not only gave a highly entertaining performance, but won by the convincing score of 4–1. Dennis Brown scored twice and young Peter Hawkins got the other two.

The reserves possess some highly promising youngsters who are well worth supporting.

Last week we appointed Charles (Mac) McCormick to be our new trainer. We wish him a happy and successful stay at the County Ground. He is already well known for his numerous sporting activities in the town and county.

Apart from his work as manager of Wellingborough, Mac has a background of being 21 years the head remedial gymnast at Northampton General Hospital and before that 12 years in the Army Physical Training Corps.






