GOSSIP FROM THE MILLER MAN

Finale visitors this evening, postponed from March, only 72 hours after that Wembley triumph, are Swindon Town who have not been here since 1965.

That was the year Danny Williams, now their manager, left us after three years as our manager (and a footballing lifetime as a Miller player). That previous occasion was a black one for Town; the fixtures were the Easter games and with a win each, Swindon went down.

Since then they have rightly earned a name for adventurous attacking football and this season have swept to League Cup final success and pace-setting in the promotion-stakes.

If the Luton-Watford match on Wednesday went the right way for Danny, Town will already be up; if not, a point tonight will be vital. It has certainly been a good Third Division finish after all. At one time it looked as though Watford (already up) and Town would go quite clear of the field well before the end of the term.

Of course, we all want Dan's team to 'make it' but our business this evening is to get 'em beaten. It will take some doing, for Swindon and Watford are, without doubt, two of the best teams to go from Division III for many seasons.



The decision of the board of directors to offer Jimmy McAnearney a two-year contract as manager has been widely welcomed wherever Rotherham football has interests.

The 34-year-old Scot from Dundee—he was 34 a few days ago—has in fact, of course, been manager since Tommy Docherty left in November. The directors decided then that they would 'review the position' at the end of the season. Such was their satisfaction with the manner of Mr. McAnearney's administration of all matters concerning players and team affairs, that they made their decision ahead of schedule.

It remains for us to wish Jimmy every success in the two years that lie ahead.


