

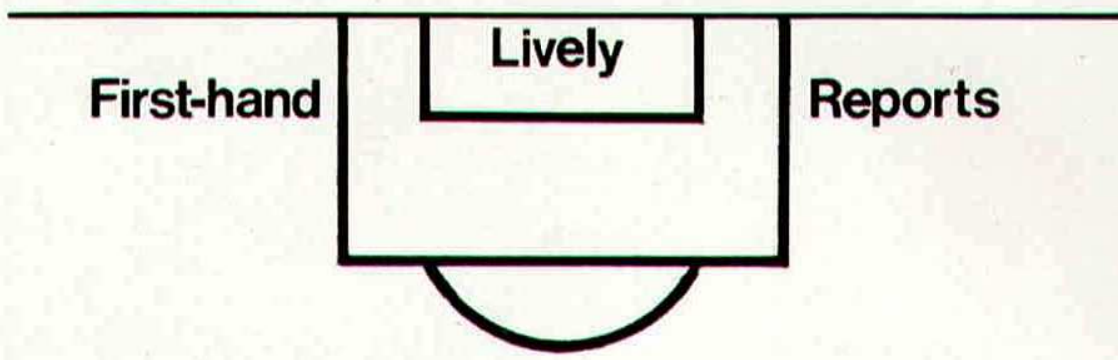

## news & views

This evening we welcome with pleasure to Swindon a fine Club, and the pride of Wales, Cardiff City. Glad to see you back. We look forward to a repeat of last week's game at Ninian Park — a great match, witnessed by one of their largest gates for a league game. Evidently we proved an attraction to the people of the valleys by virtue of our success in winning the League Cup. Swindon, as always, had a wonderful following of real and loyal supporters. It was a pleasure to travel on the train with them, no sign of trouble or disturbance. One again Swindon came back, when I am sure most of us present felt we were in for a heavy defeat. Cardiff, two goals up in seventeen minutes, were riding high, full of confidence. No signs of panic in our team, or recriminations, quietly and efficiently the players got into their stride and began to get on top, so much so that, at half-time, the scores were level.

Games between our two Clubs have been very keen and usually very close. The two most outstanding in present memories are the two cup-battles in Round 3 in season 1951/52. Cardiff occupied a high position in Division I, but before an almost capacity gate (half of whom were Swindon Supporters) we drew 1—1, Maurice Owen scoring the all important goal. Swindon won the replay 1—0, Maurice Owen again the scorer, and went on to play Stoke City, but lost in the following round at Luton. Many will remember that fine team: Uprichard; Hunt (still with us), May; Kaye, Hudson, Gray; Lunn (whom we are sorry to say is very ill in the Princess Margaret Hospital. Get well soon, Harry), Onslow (still in Swindon), Owen (first team trainer), Betteridge, Bain.

Swindon and Cardiff last played each other in season 1964/65. The first game took place at Swindon on 17th October, 1964. We were leading 2—0, when Ken Macpherson (centre-half) was injured and had to leave the field. Swindon played the whole of the second half with ten men (no substitutes allowed then), but after Cardiff had scored we made it 3—1. But unfortunately the loss of a player weighed heavily on our team, as we conceded two more goals to make the score 3—3 and the loss of a very valuable point, which told at the end of the season. Ernie Hunt played under some strain, because later that day he was rushed to hospital for an operation. Swindon team: Oakley; Dawson, Trollope; Morgan, Macpherson, Smart; Leggett, Hunt, Summerbee, Skeen, Rogers. Cardiff City: Wilson; Rodrigues, Peck; Williams, Murray, Hole; Farrell, King, P., Tapscott, Charles, M., Lewis.

The return game was played on Saturday, 27th February, 1965, when fears of relegation were looming up. Swindon did not play very well, and lost 0—2, both goals coming in the second half. Both teams were almost the same as played in the first game, but John Charles played at centre-half for Cardiff.

This season has seen the departure from the County Ground of a long and faithful servant — namely Mr. Reg Wise. He has retired and given up the catering facilities. Reg was a wonderful supporter of the Club, and helped it tremendously in the early 'fifties. At that time support was very low, and the Club almost went out of existence. Despite the poor attendance, he continued to serve refreshments in a most efficient manner, although he could have made very little profit, in fact sometimes a loss. But he still helped by donations to the Club.

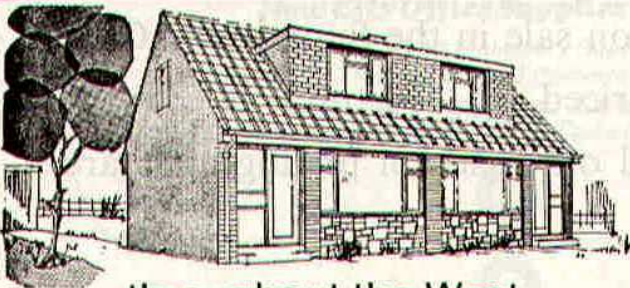

## CARDIFF CITY A.F.C. PEN PICTURES SEASON 1969-70

### **FRED DAVIES (Goalkeeper)**

Born Liverpool. Made his Cardiff debut in January 1968 after being transferred from Wolves. Was a regular at Molineux for several seasons. Began his career with Llanudno in the Welsh League. League appearances for Cardiff at the end of last season: 59.

### **DAVID CARVER (Full Back)**

Born Rotherham. Left his home-town club to join City in January 1966 and was one of the Club's most consistent players last season. Can play in either full back position. Career League appearances for Cardiff: 83.

### **GARY BELL (Full Back)**

Born Halesowen. Made his debut in September 1966 but it was only last season that he gained a regular first-team place. Joined the Club from Lower Gornal Athletic of the West Midlands League — as a left winger. Has been converted into a full back with great success. Career League appearances: 39.

### **MEL SUTTON (Wing Half)**

Born Birmingham. Made his debut as recently as last August and became one of the Club's outstanding players. Went to Ninian Park in November 1967 on a fortnight's trial after being released by Aston Villa with whom he had been an amateur. Turned professional after the end of his trial period — and hasn't looked back since. Total League appearances: 30.

### **DON MURRAY (Centre Half)**

Born Duffus. First played for the Club at the end of the 1962/63 season. Has appeared once in Scotland's Under 23 team and succeeded Brian Harris last season as City's skipper. Has been the Club's undisputed top-choice centre half now for four seasons. Total League appearances for Cardiff: 206.

### **BRIAN HARRIS (Wing Half)**

Born Bebington. Played a great part in hoisting the team off the bottom of the Second Division Table in season 1966/67 after being signed from Everton. Appeared in almost 400 matches for the Goodison Park club and was a member of their F.A. Cup winning team in 1966.

### **BARRIE JONES (Outside Right)**

Born Swansea. Holds 13 Welsh Caps, having been recalled to the national side last March after an absence of some four years. Signed for Cardiff in March 1967 after £22,000 transfer terms had been agreed with Plymouth — the club who, in 1964, paid a British record winger's fee of £45,000 to buy him from Swansea. Total League matches for City: 95.

### **LES LEA (Outside Left/Inside Forward)**

Born Manchester. Joined City in December 1967 after spending seven seasons with Blackpool at Bloomfield Road. Has played in a variety of forward line positions and appeared most often at inside forward. Total League matches for City: 44.

### **BRIAN CLARK (Inside or Centre Forward)**

Born Bristol. Scored almost a century of goals in six seasons with Bristol City, then moved to Huddersfield. Returned nearer his native West Country when Cardiff City signed him from Huddersfield for a four-figure fee. Scored 17 goals last season to finish high in the leading list of Second Division marksmen.

### **PETER KING (Inside or Centre Forward/Right or Left Wing)**

Born Worcester. The Club's longest-serving player, having first appeared in 1961. Joined the Ninian Park staff in a player-exchange deal and has played in every one of the five forward positions. Asked for a transfer last season but later withdrew his request. Was troubled by injury in mid-season but got over it to carry the No. 9 shirt. Career facts: 245 matches, 48 goals.

### **JOHN TOSHACK (Inside Forward/Centre Forward)**

Born Cardiff. Topped the Second Division scoring list last season with 22 goals. Also won his first Welsh caps. Played in the matches against West Germany, East Germany, Scotland, England and Northern Ireland. Still only 20.

### **LEIGHTON PHILLIPS (Wing Half/Inside Forward)**

Born Briton Ferry. Captained the City Youth team which reached the quarter-finals of the Youth Cup two seasons ago. Still in his teens. Seven League appearances for Cardiff.

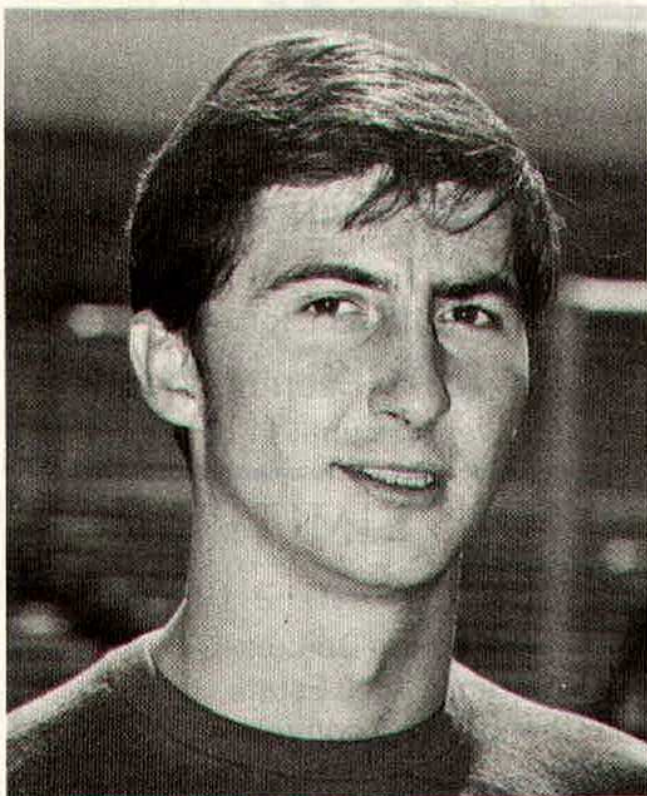

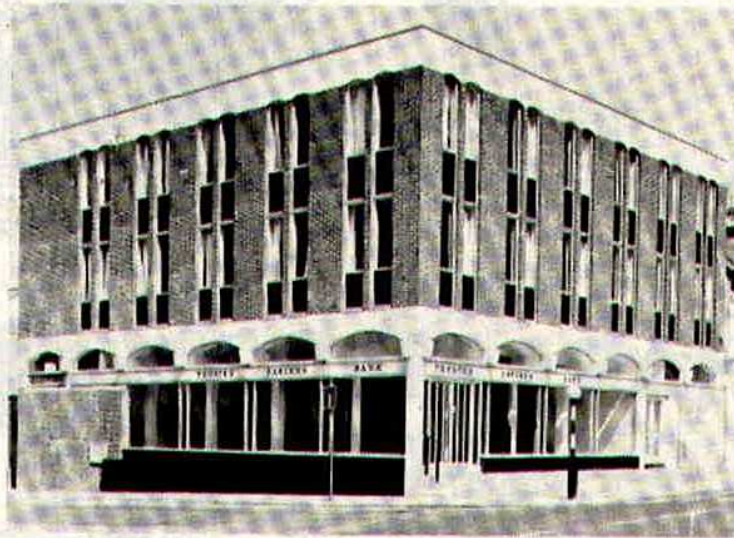
